Regional Reopening Information

Governor Cuomo has announced that New York State will reopen on a regional basis using a four-phased approach.

- **Phase 1:** Construction, Manufacturing, Wholesale Trade, Select Retail for Curbside Pickup Only, Agriculture/Forestry/Fishing
- **Phase 2:** Professional Services, Finance and Insurance, Retail, Administrative Support Real Estate, Rental, and Leasing, Vehicle sales/leases/rentals, outdoor and take-out/delivery food services.
- **Phase 3:** Restaurants and Food Services, personal care.
- **Phase 4:** Arts/Entertainment/Recreation, Education

The ten regions for reopening across New York State are the same as the Regional Economic Development Councils, and reopening was originally based on the ability of each region to meet seven metrics. It is now based on testing and the percentage of positive tests by region.
